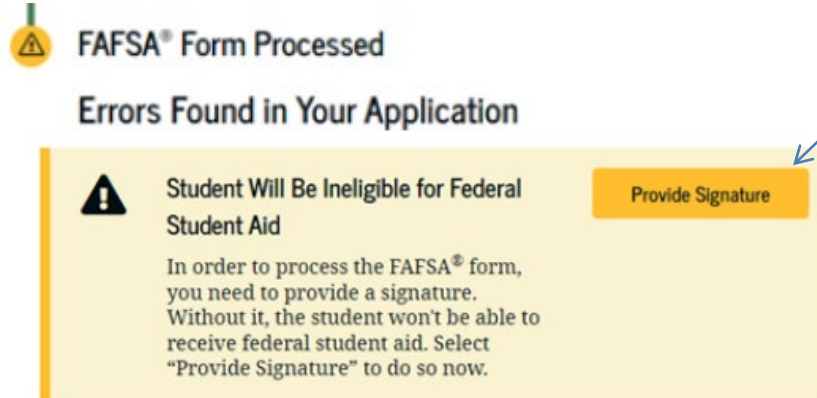
1. Parent will log into [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) using the parent FSA ID and password and select **2024-25 FAFSA Form** from the “My Activity” section of your account Dashboard.

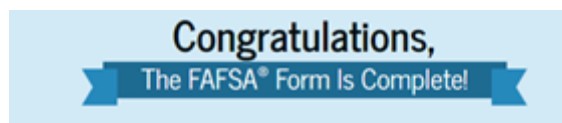
