

Transfer College Agreements

2007-2008

- **Program Articulation Agreements:** Designed for specific noted academic programs, these designate both transferred courses and remaining academic requirements to be completed at the transfer college/university.
- **General Agreement:** Document that stipulates criteria for transfer from CCC to a specific college/university. In most cases addresses GPA, some course information, transfer of credit and some privileges due the student because of the agreement. Does not address specific programs or majors.
- **Course Equivalencies:** A list of CCC courses and their equivalent courses at a specific college/university. May also indicate how the course will generically transfer (toward general education, major or elective).
- **2 + 2 Agreements:** Agreements that list criteria for students to transfer from CCC to a specific college/university. Included in the criteria would be specific course requirements to complete the degree without loss of credit.
- **Joint Admissions:** A document that connects the CCC application process and a specific college/university. Students would be accepted to both institutions with the CCC application, but must meet specified criteria in the agreement (degree completion, GPA requirements, course selection).
- **General Education:** The liberal arts courses required of all students at a specific college/university by category (humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, fine arts, math, etc.) no matter what their major. At most universities there will be university wide general education and general education required at the specific college within the university. In some cases the lower division general education may be waived (articulation agreements, SUNY to SUNY) for students with an AA or AS from CCC.

Special Note:

CCC transfer programs are designed to include courses that are generally transferable. A potential college will evaluate your CCC courses on a course by course basis. All final transfer decisions are reserved for and maintained by the transfer college/university.
