Grant funding and the requirements of funders have changed over the years. Beyond just a request for money, a grant becomes both an appeal and a plan for how the applicant will use the money to benefit the world. The organization that can write an application that clearly explains its idea and the benefit that it will bring to the community will be more likely to receive funds. Since competition for grant funds has increased, the skills needed to write them well have, too.

In this one-day session, experienced grant writers from the Institute for Human Services will lead a workshop that outlines the preparation methods, research strategies, writing tips and follow-up needed to boost your organization's skill in preparing and submitting competitive grant applications.
