Headcount

Headcount breakdown: 3388 students, (down slightly from Fall 2005, when comparing to non-ACE headcount on the first day)

- 2353 Full-time students, 1035 Part-time students
- 58% continuing, 25% new, 5% transfer, 7% readmit, 5% non-degree

FTEs: 1344 FTEs, (down slightly from Fall 2005, when comparing to non-ACE FTEs on the first day)

- 1131 Full-time FTEs, 213 Part-time FTEs

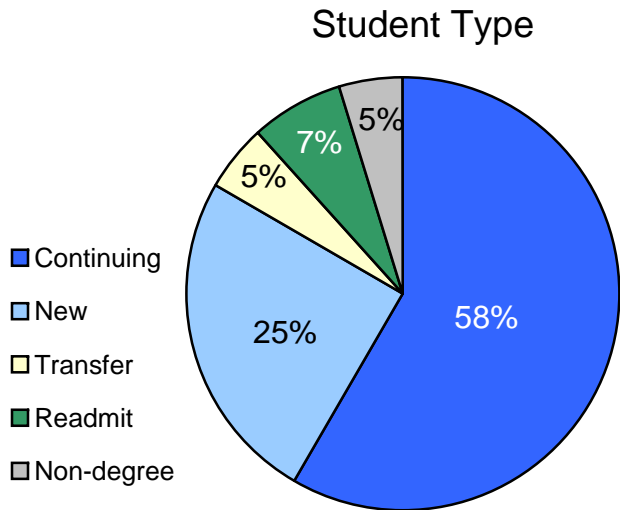
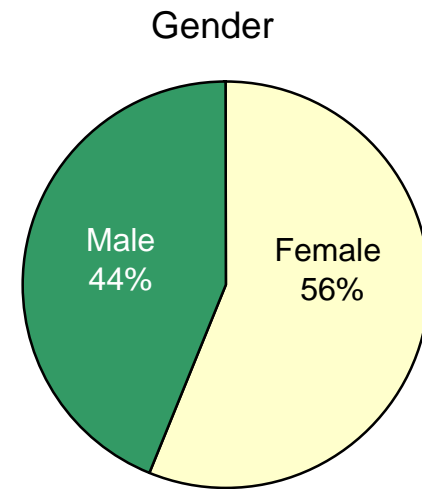
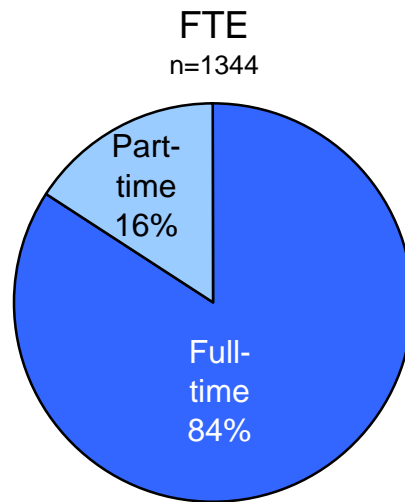
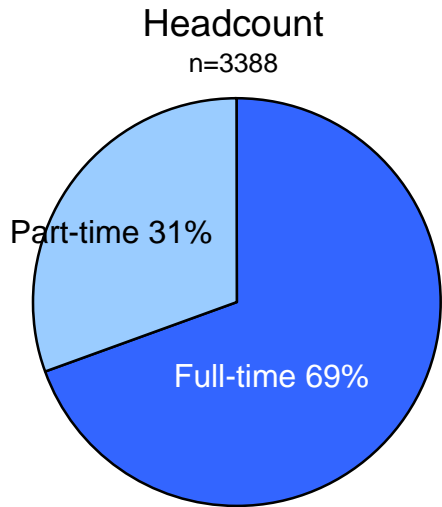
