Headcount: 3405 students

- Virtually unchanged from Fall 2006, when comparing to non-ACE headcount on the first day
- 2348 Full-time students, 1057 Part-time students
- 53% continuing, 30% new, 5% transfer, 6% readmit, 6% non-matriculated

FTEs: 1338 FTEs

- Virtually unchanged from Fall 2006, when comparing to non-ACE headcount on the first day
- 1123 Full-time FTEs, 215 Part-time FTEs
- 49% continuing, 36% new, 6% transfer, 6% readmit, 3% non-matriculated

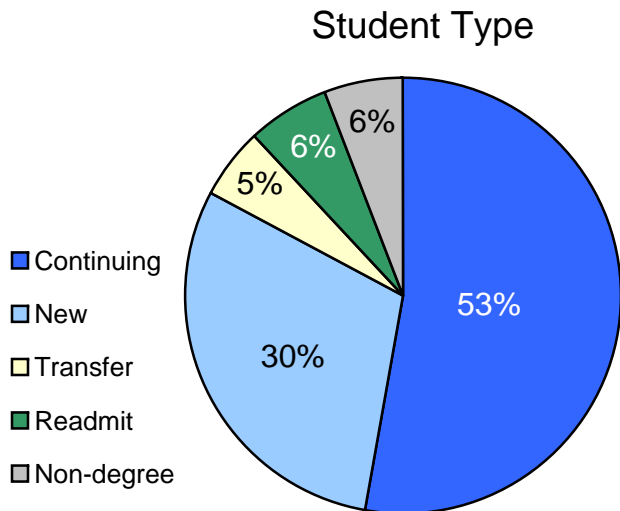
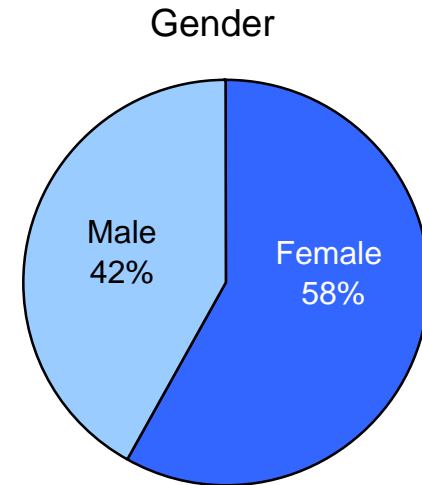
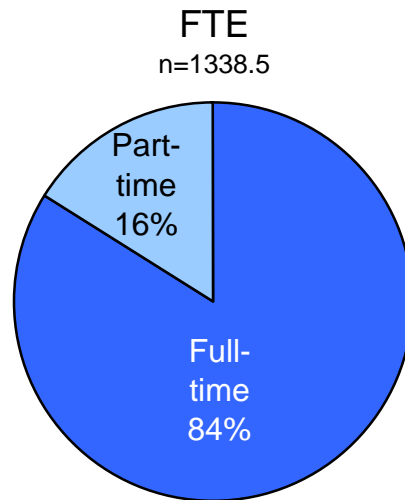
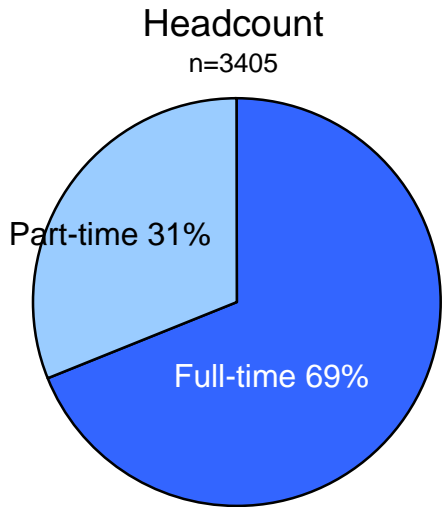

Fall 2007: First Day Snapshot of Students



Shown below is the age breakdown of the approximately 3400 students who are enrolled on the first day of Fall 2007:

- 38% are 19 or younger
- 27% are 20-25
- 12% are 26-30
- 12% are 31-40
- 8% are 41-50
- 3% are 51 or older

The average (mean) age = 25.8
The median age = 21
