2+2 Partnership Program Agreement

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2+2 PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM AGREEMENT

This agreement establishes a 2+2 Partnership Program Agreement between SUNY Corning Community College and St. John Fisher University. Students selected for matriculation in this program will, upon completion of a prescribed sequence of courses leading to an associate degree from SUNY Corning Community College, continue their studies at St. John Fisher University with assurance that they may complete the 60 semester credit hours in conformity with the academic standards of St. John Fisher University and as prescribed in the appropriate Advising Guides (certain majors may require the completion of more than two-years of full-time study).

STUDENT SELECTION

SUNY Corning Community College will be responsible for the selection of candidates for admission to the 2+2 Partnership Program. In general, applicants will be expected to present strong records of academic achievement including four years of English, three years of social studies, and mathematics, and at least two years of study in science. In addition, SUNY Corning Community College will designate appropriate prerequisites for matriculation in any of the curricula included in the 2+2 program.

BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

The following programs and majors may be selected by students who enroll in the 2+2 Partnership Program between SUNY Corning Community College and St. John Fisher University:

GPA REQUIREMENTS

In no instance shall a student graduating with an associate degree from SUNY Coming Community College be expected to meet St. John Fisher University higher GPA standards than a St. John Fisher University student entering the junior year. St. John Fisher College policies and procedures as to academic standing, however, shall apply. Students interested in all majors

included in the 2+2 program must present a minimum GPA of 2.0. Some degree programs may require higher GPA's and/or pre-requisite coursework to continue at St. John Fisher University. Please refer to appropriate Advising Guides.

In the case of other baccalaureate programs which are not covered by the 2+2 agreement, or in the case when a student changes from his/her originally intended 2+2 major, SUNY Coming Community College students shall follow normal procedures for transfer admission. Students will be subject to the same requirements for these programs as other students applying, including those having completed lower-division work at St. John Fisher University.

STUDENT ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT

SUNY Coming Community College staff will assume responsibility for advising students who enroll in the 2+2 program. Advising guides will be used as the mechanism for communicating degree requirements to students. Guidesheets will be reviewed periodically and appropriate revisions to advising guides will be made as each institution adds, deletes, or changes course offerings.

When appropriate, staff members from St. John Fisher University will offer special orientation/advisement sessions for 2+2 students at SUNY Coming Community College. When appropriate, St. John Fisher University agrees to meet with faculty and staff at SUNY Coming Community College who will be involved in consulting with and advising students enrolled in the 2+2 program.

Staff members from SUNY Coming Community College and the Transfer and Graduate Admissions Office at St. John Fisher University will be designated as contact persons and coordinators of this 2+2 program agreement.

ARTICULATION PROCEDURES

Participants are required to submit a separate SJF Transfer Application (available on-line at <https://www.sjf.edu/admissions-aid/transfer-admissions/applying-to-fisher/>) the semester before intended enrollment at St. John Fisher University. There is no application fee required for consideration into St. John Fisher University.

Students who wish to change their majors upon enrolling at St. John Fisher University will be permitted to do so and may still be able to earn their baccalaureate degrees with the completion of 60 additional credit hours. In cases such as majors in disciplines which are sequential, or which require a large number of sequence courses and professional programs which are highly structured, pursuit of a different baccalaureate degree at St. John Fisher University may require the completion of more than 60 credit hours.

Each semester, SUNY Coming Community College will provide acceptance lists and transcripts of students enrolled in 2+2 programs. This will allow St. John Fisher University to monitor the flow of students through the program. Biographic and academic data on each student will be provided to the Transfer and Graduate Admissions Office at St. John Fisher University so that literature and


other relevant programmatic information can be sent to students during the time that they are pursuing their studies at SUNY Cortland Community College.

TIME FRAME AND PROVISION FOR PROGRAM REVIEW

All students currently enrolled at SUNY Corning Community College and those admitted to begin their studies at SUNY Corning Community College in Fall 2024 through Spring 2029, are eligible to be considered for this 2+2 program.
