## **Academic and Career Pathways**

What is Your Academic Major/Program?

- Selected by you and focused on your career interest.

What are the Course Requirements for Your Academic Major/Program.

- Typically each degree requires 62-64 credit hours of coursework to be completed to meet graduation requirements.
- Most programs require general education coursework along with specific courses directed towards your major.



## **Academic and Career Pathways**

#### **Get the Right Classes**

- Setting up an appointment with an Enrollment Specialist or Faculty (Academic) Advisor
- Knowing your availability with considering if you are working and your life responsibilities.
- We offer a variety of class options.
- Schedule what works best for you.
  - Day, Evening or on the Weekends.
  - In-Class, Online or Hybrid (combination of In-Class and Online)



## **Online Learning**

#### **Variety of Course Delivery Modes:**

- Online/Internet: Enables students to work online, at their own pace without live class sessions. There are deadlines for course activities and assignments, but students access the course material when it is convenient for them.
- **Remote:** Classes are held online on specific days/times. Blackboard Collaborate, found inside your Blackboard course, is the most frequently used online meeting tool by our faculty. Students automatically have access to Blackboard and Blackboard Collaborate when they register for a course.
- Hybrid Courses: A combination of online/remote learning, along with the possibility of face-to-face instructions or exams.

\*Having computer and internet access is essential to your success, as a majority courses have some type of online requirement. If you have questions or concerns, please reach out to our office for information about resources, including our laptop loan program\*

#### Student Services and Financial Aid

- Registration: add/drop classes, look up classes, view Degreeworks, see detail schedule
- Student Records: view holds, unofficial transcript, request official transcript, enrollment verification, view Degreeworks
- Financial Aid: check Financial Aid status, view/accept award,
- Student Accounts: make payments online, view bill, access MATRIX purchase meal plan and view aid available to you in Bookstore

- Create Account (Username and Pin)


