What is the truth about how to succeed in college?







How important is sleep anyway?



 If you have an exam the next day, the best approach to studying would be to study 4 or 5 hours through the night, sleep just 3 to 4 hours, and then take the test. In this way, the information is fresh in your mind and you can catch up on sleep the next night.





FALSE



- NEVER CRAM! We lose most information within 16 hours of learning it- this is called the Curve of Forgetting. SO- if you cram just once, and the night before an exam, no matter how much- or how little- sleep you get, most of the information is gone before you walk into the test!
- Sleep is vital! You can't make up for sleep. And, during one phase of sleep-REM (not the band!) – the brain actually consolidates all of your learning into memory......

- For every one hour in class, you need 2 hours each week to read, study, do homework, etc.
- Make sure you allow yourself enough time Time Management is Key!



Stress- a good motivator?

 Adrenaline is a chemical that really helps with learning and motivation. The higher the stress level, the better because adrenaline strengthens memory.







FALSE

 For optimal success, you need a moderate level of arousal – enough to get you motivated to work hard and study but not panic which can actually decrease your ability to pull information that you truly know from your brain (Yerkes- Dobson Law) - the Baby Bear approach. Just Right.





Stress and your Shrinking Brain



 Long-term exposure to stress can actually shrink a part of your brain called the Hippocampus. Guess what that controls?





Learning and Memory!

- So...the moral of the story is:
 - A. Don't cram! Do a lot a little and a little a lot
 - B. Get enough Sleep! And listen to REM
 - C. Be realistic with your time- Time Management will help.


